A FEW SUGGESTIONS FOR ACTIVITIES TO BUILD ON WHAT STUDENTS HAVE LEARNED.

THE STUDENT WITH THEMSELVES

- Ask your students how they feel when they experience something unfair or unjust.
- Guide your students to develop their own understanding of justice, ethics, empathy, diversity, differences, etc.

THE STUDENT WITH OTHERS

- Provide opportunities for conversation and encourage your students to ask personalized questions during these conversations.
- Use a rewards system to encourage students when they do something positive for another student.
- Carry out a project presenting the resources available in your community or neighborhood.
- Organize a volunteering activity with your class in your school neighborhood.



WHAT IS SOCIAL AWARENESS?

- Taking the perspectives of other people
- Recognizing strengths in others
- Showing empathy and compassion
- Showing concern for the feelings of others
- Understanding and expressing gratitude

- Identifying diverse social norms, including unjust ones
- Recognizing situational demands and opportunities
- Understanding the influences of organizations/systems on behavior
